CHRISTMAS PERFORMANCES NEXT WEEK

KS2 Carol Service (Y3 to Y6)

Monday (12th December) is our KS2 Carol Service at St John the Divine Church at 6pm.

Children should arrive at church no earlier than 5.40pm and no later than 5.50pm. Please bring your child into the church via the main entrance and send them to sit with their teachers for the service - Year 5 and 6 will sit in the choir stalls in their agreed spaces; Years 3 and 4 will sit in the front pews in the central aisle of the church. Parents - please keep your child's coat with you when you send them to sit with their class.

Children should wear their normal school uniform, including black school shoes, with either a Christmas jumper, Christmas hat or Christmas hair decoration for the service. At the end of the service, parents will be asked to remain in their seats and children will be dismissed in year groups to come and find their grown ups to ensure everyone gets home safely.

Please remember each child is only able to bring one adult to watch the service due to space in the church; the service will be recorded and added to our private YouTube channel after the event for any other family members wishing to watch.

F2 & KS1 Nativity (F2, Y1 and Y6)

On Thursday 15th December at 2.30pm and then again at 6pm, children will be performing a nativity play in the school hall. On Thursday evening please bring the children back to school at 5.45pm to get ready for the performance.

The children will need dark bottoms (joggers, trouser, leggings) and a dark top without a logo. We will be making head-dresses in school for the different parts. The children will need to bring their clothes into school in a clearly named carrier bag on Monday if they have not done so already.
